*Global Report of the HIV/AIDS epidemic - December 2000*

**T**he Regional Program on AIDS and STI of the Division of Disease Prevention and Control of the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO) provides technical expertise for the prevention and control of HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in the Region of the Americas. The mandate for PAHO's Regional Program on AIDS and STIs is to promote, design, and facilitate technical activities and policies to improve the capacity of Member States to reduce the number of future infections and to provide timely and adequate care for people living with HIV/AIDS/STI.

The Regional Program is part of a broader set of culturally sensitive, gender-specific, multinational, and multisectoral responses to HIV/AIDS and STIs in the Americas. The Program provides technical support within the following framework:

- ✓ Dissemination of information
- ✓ Training
- ✓ Direct technical cooperation
- ✓ Resource mobilization

## **Objectives:**

- ✓ **Advocate** for HIV/STI prevention and control at the country level in Latin America and the Caribbean
- ✓ **Strengthen management** capacity to develop and implement policies for HIV and STI prevention and control
- ✓ **Involve** nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) in prevention and control efforts and build networks among NGOs at the country level
- ✓ **Provide direct technical cooperation** to Member States including, but not limited to, epidemiological analysis, development of educational materials and country HIV/STI surveillance reports, laboratory support for STI diagnosis, and improvement of blood safety measures, etc.
- ✓ **Promote** research about HIV/AIDS epidemiological trends, their relation to other STIs, prevention messages, monitoring of socioeconomic impact, etc.
- ✓ **Foster technical cooperation** among countries to encourage the exchange of technical experience, as well as lessons learned and success stories
- ✓ **Strengthen sentinel surveillance**, and advise and train professionals to monitor HIV/AIDS/STI infections and trends at the country level

**AIDS Surveillance in the Americas Report.** PAHO began its AIDS surveillance system in 1986, although cases had been reported informally to PAHO since 1983. The information is currently submitted to PAHO from 47 countries and territories of the Region of the Americas. These data are received within 30 to 45 days after the end of each quarter. PAHO then produces the present report, which is distributed to all the countries in the Region. Twice a year PAHO sends the information to the World Health Organization headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland, where data are gathered from all regions and published as the Global AIDS Report.

As of **December 2000**, a cumulative total of **1,184,651** cases were reported in the Americas. From these, **20,546** are pediatric cases (<15 years old), equivalent to **1.73** percent. A total of **603,925** cumulative deaths have been reported since 1986. It is estimated that these figures may be higher since data is incomplete for **1999-2000**.

Certain factors such as under-diagnosis, and under- and delayed reporting affect the completeness of the data. These factors should be considered when analyzing the data. Additionally, often the countries provide the number of cases by year but do not report the corresponding age, sex, and exposure category for those cases.

PAHO and its Member States are working continuously to improve the quality and completeness of the information, to be able to analyze and provide a better profile of the epidemic in each successive report.

The Regional Program on AIDS and STI in collaboration with the WHO/PAHO/UNAIDS Working Group on Global HIV/AIDS and STI Surveillance has developed several documents that are available through PAHO or at our web site ([www.paho.org](http://www.paho.org)).








Total cumulative AIDS cases in the Southern Cone (1982-Dec. 2000): 23,189

1982-Dec. 2000







1980-Dec. 2000






Total cumulative AIDS cases in Central America (1983-Dec. 2000): 24,826




Total cumulative AIDS cases in Mexico (1983-Dec. 2000): 47,870

1983-Dec. 2000




Total cumulative AIDS cases in Latin Caribbean (1981-Dec. 2000): 15,477




Total cumulative AIDS cases in the Caribbean (1981-Dec. 2000): 17,719




