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BIENNIAL PROGRAM BUDGET PROPOSAL FOR 2004-2005

The 56th World Health Assembly took place in May 2003. The budget appropriation for the World Health Organization approved through resolution WHA56.32 resulted in a lower budget amount for the Region of the Americas than had been recommended by the 111th Executive Board and subsequently presented to the Assembly. The amount originally submitted to the Assembly by the Executive Board for the Region of the Americas was \$75,399,000, which is the amount included in the overall PAHO/WHO regular budget proposal presented to the 132nd Session of the Executive Committee as *Official Document 307*. The amount of the budget approved for the Region of the Americas by the Assembly through resolution WHA56.32 is \$73,230,000, a net reduction of \$2,169,000 from the original proposed amount. The impact and effect of this reduction on the combined PAHO/WHO regular program budget proposal for 2004-2005 is detailed in the attached revised tables and Annexes labeled Revision 1. Tables 1-3 are found in the introductory portion of *Official Document 307*; Annexes 1 and 3 are found in the back of the document.

The budget level of 264,773,000 initially proposed in *Official Document 307*, has been reduced to a new budget level of 262,604,000 to reflect the reduction of 2,169,000 in the WHO share of the Proposed PAHO/WHO Program Budget. The new budget level of 262,604,000 results in an increase of 0.4% with respect to the previous biennium.

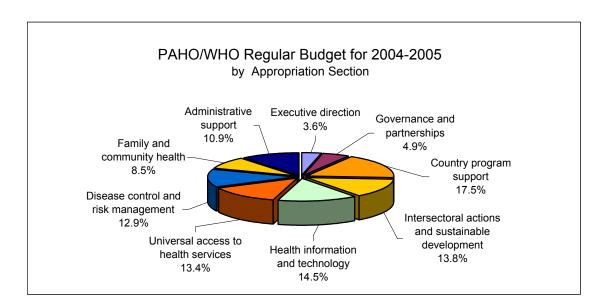

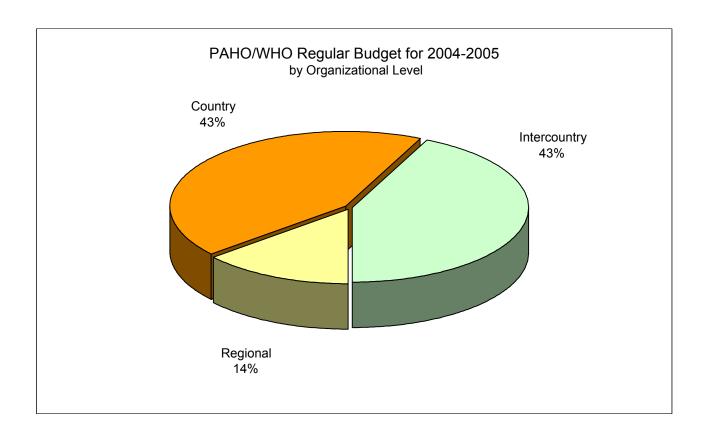
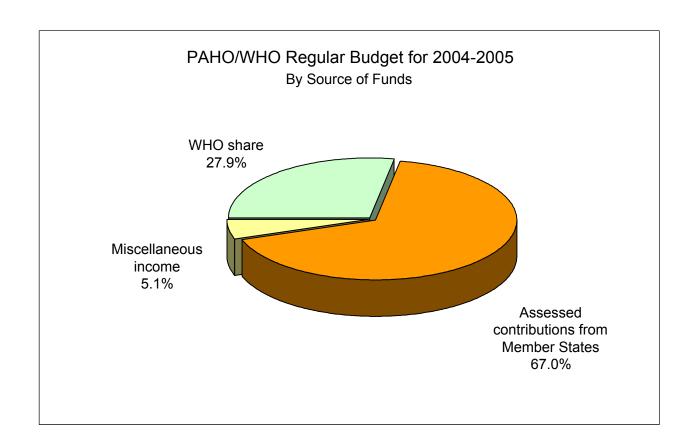
