## ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER STATES TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE EXPIRATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF BAHAMAS, CHILE, AND COSTA RICA

Article 15.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization provides that the Executive Committee will be composed of nine Member States of the Organization elected by the Conference or the Council for overlapping periods of three years. A Member State will not be eligible for re-election to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed since the expiration of its term of office.
