ELECTION OF THREE MEMBER STATES TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ON THE EXPIRATION OF THE PERIODS OF OFFICE OF CANADA, CUBA, AND VENEZUELA

1. Article 15.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization provides that the Executive Committee will be composed of nine Member States of the Organization elected by the Conference or the Directing Council for overlapping periods of three years. A Member State will not be eligible for re-election to the Executive Committee until one year has elapsed since the expiration of its term of office.

2. The following list shows the composition of the Executive Committee with the expiration dates of the terms of the present Members:

Canada	September 2007
Cuba	September 2007
Venezuela	September 2007
Antigua and Barbuda	September 2008
Chile	September 2008
Panama	September 2008
Trinidad and Tobago	September 2009
United States of America	September 2009
Uruguay	September 2009

3. It is incumbent upon the Conference, in conformity with Article 4.D of the Constitution, to elect the Member States to replace Canada, Cuba, and Venezuela, whose periods of office on the Committee expire as of the close of this Pan American Sanitary Conference.

4. Once three Member States have been elected, the Conference may wish to adopt a resolution along the following lines:

Proposed Resolution

THE 27th PAN AMERICAN SANITARY CONFERENCE,

Bearing in mind the provision of Articles 4.D and 15.A of the Constitution of the Pan American Health Organization; and

Considering that _____, _____ and _____ were elected to serve on the Executive Committee upon the expiration of the periods of office of Canada, Cuba, and Venezuela,

RESOLVES:

1. To declare _____, _____, and _____ elected to membership on the Executive Committee for a period of three years.
2. To thank Canada, Cuba, and Venezuela for the services rendered to the Organization during the past three years by their delegates on the Executive Committee.
